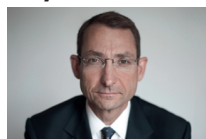

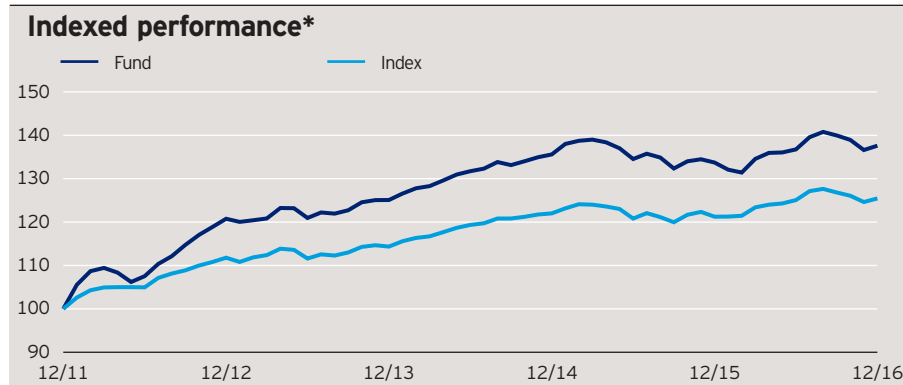

### Quarterly fund commentary

Euro denominated corporate bond markets gave back some of their recent strong gains during the last three months of 2016. The sell-off was led by the global government bond market, which came under pressure from rising inflation expectations. The rise in yields and importantly an increase in the yield spread between short and long dated bonds provide a more profitable interest rate environment for banks. This helped the banking sector to outperform the broader corporate bond market. Index data from Merrill Lynch shows euro investment grade corporate bonds lost 1.3%, while Euro banks lost 0.4% (Euro, total return). We remain defensively positioned, with a relatively high allocation to liquidity. We hold a diversified portfolio of investment grade bonds with a smaller allocation to non-financial corporate high yield bonds. Our preferred sector remains financials with further notable holdings in non-financial hybrid bonds (relatively junior bonds in a company's capital structure). Around 18% of the fund is held in US dollar denominated bonds (hedged back to euro). Given the divergent monetary policies of the US and Europe, these bonds can provide an additional level of income over their European counterparts.

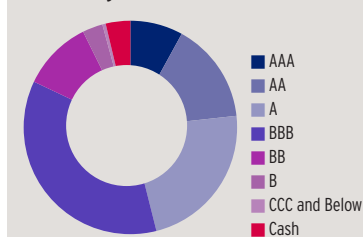
