

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#### Quarterly fund commentary

The third guarter of 2015 has been an eventful one. Elevated levels of volatility caused by the fallout from a slowing China, the reality that a Eurozone member could someday leave the currency union after Greece's debt negotiations went down to the wire and the ongoing speculation around when the US Federal Reserve (Fed) will begin raising interest rates have all played their part. Twelve-month Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) inflation remained weak throughout the period, with the measure dipping into negative territory in September with a reading of -0.1%. However, in the wake of this and the potential that growth in the region will not materialise, the European Central Bank (ECB) has been quick to increase rhetoric around further easing monetary policy. Going forward, we believe that the euro inflation-linked bond market has already priced in an overly benign inflation path given better growth data and the aggressive ECB policy. We have a preference for Italian and German inflation linked bonds and have tactical exposure to Sweden.
