
# Invesco European Growth Equity Fund **C-Acc Shares**

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#### Quarterly fund commentary

Over the quarter, we continued to look for opportunities to improve the quality of the portfolio by adding and/or selling companies based on the team's EQV (Earnings, Quality and Valuation) outlook for each company. New additions to the portfolio included a Switzerlandbased global luxury consumer goods company; a UK based inter-dealer money broker and a German based courier company. We sold the holdings in one name over the period - an independent oil and gas company - which was acquired over the quarter. Global data indicating slowing economic conditions combined with devaluation of the Chinese renminbi contributed to a sharp sell-off in global equities during the third quarter. Europe enjoyed relative tranquility after the Greek bailout package. Within this environment, valuations of what we view as high-quality companies on our watch list have improved. Therefore, if shortterm market weakness continues, we will seek to take advantage of lower share prices for these companies. Regardless of the macroeconomic environment, we remain focused on a bottom-up investment approach of identifying attractive companies that fit our EQV (Earnings, Quality, Valuation) investment process.
