I. FUND INFORMATION

Investment Objective

The LYXOR UCITS ETF RUSSELL 1000 GROWTH is a UCITS compliant exchange traded fund that aims to track as closely as possible the benchmark index Russell 1000 Growth Net Total Return by entering into a return swap contract. For this specific index, Lyxor provides through its swap based ETF the most efficient way of tracking the benchmark, with an expected lower tracking error, while the swap counterparty risk is targeted at 0% via a daily reset mechanism associated with a full property and control of all the assets held. Lyxor ETFs are efficient investment vehicles listed on exchange that offer transparent, liquid and low-cost exposure to the underlying benchmark index.





REPLICATION RISK: The fund objectives might not be reached due to unexpected events on the underlying markets which will impact the index calculation and the efficient fund replication. COUNTERPARTY RISK: Investors are exposed to risks resulting from the use of an OTC Swap with Societe Generale. In-line with UCITS guidelines, the exposure to Societe Generale cannot exceed 10% of the total fund assets.

UNDERLYING RISK: The Underlying Index of a Lyxor ETF may be complex and volatile. When investing in commodities, the Underlying Index is calculated with reference to commodity futures contracts exposing the investor to a liquidity risk linked to costs such as cost of carry and transportation.
