I. FUND INFORMATION

Investment Objective

The LYXOR UCITS ETF S&P 500 Capped Utilities Sector is a UCITS compliant exchange traded fund that aims to track as closely as possible the benchmark index S&P 500 Utilities NTR by entering into a return swap contract. For this specific index, Lyxor provides through its swap based ETF the most efficient way of tracking the benchmark, with an expected lower tracking error, while the swap counterparty risk is targeted at 0% via a daily reset mechanism associated with a full property and control of all the assets held.

Lyxor ETFs are efficient investment vehicles listed on exchange that offer transparent, liquid and low-cost exposure to the underlying benchmark index.


