FUND INFORMATION

Description

Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs)

A UCITS ETF is a UCITS at least one unit or share class of which is traded throughout the day on at least one regulated market or Multilateral Trading Facility with at least one market maker which takes action to ensure that the stock exchange value of its units or shares does not significantly vary from its net asset value and where applicable its Indicative Net Asset Value.

Investment Objective

Lyxor Exchange Traded Funds ('ETFs') are UCITS compliant funds which track a benchmark index by investing in listed equities and entering into total or price return swaps to achieve the index performance. Swap enhanced ETFs are the most efficient way of index tracking resulting in lower tracking error while the swap counterparty bears the risk and cost of tracking index.

The investment objective is to track both the upward and downward evolution of the Topix Gross Total Return Index (Bloomberg code: TPXDDVD) representative of all the Japanese common stocks listed on the Tokyo Stock Exchange First Section (""Benchmark Index")). The anticipated ex-post tracking error under normal market conditions is 0.10%. The Fund seeks to achieve its objective via indirect tracking, i.e. by entering into an over-the-counter swap contract (financial derivative instrument, the "FDI"). The Fund will invest in a diversified portfolio of international equities, the performance of which will be swapped against that of the Benchmark Index via the FDI. An up-to-date breakdown of the Fund's investment portfolio is provided on the website. The net asset value is also shown on the Fund's Reuters and Bloomberg pages, and may also be mentioned on the websites for markets where the Fund is listed. The Fund invests at least 75% of its assets in securities that are eligible for French Share Savings Schemes. The unit currency is the US Dollar.

Risk Factors

CAPITAL AT RISK: ETFs are tracking instruments: Their risk profile is similar to a direct investment in the Underlying Index. Investors' capital is fully at risk and investors may not get back the amount originally invested.

REPLICATION RISK: The fund objectives might not be reached due to unexpected events on the underlying markets which will impact the index calculation and the efficient fund replication.

COUNTERPARTY RISK: Investors are exposed to risks resulting from the use of an OTC Swap with Societe Generale. In-line with UCITS guidelines, the exposure to Societe Generale cannot exceed 10% of the total fund assets

UNDERLYING RISK: The Underlying Index of a Lyxor ETF may be complex and volatile. When investing in commodities, the Underlying Index is calculated with reference to commodity futures contracts exposing the investor to a liquidity risk linked to costs such as cost of carry and transportation. 
